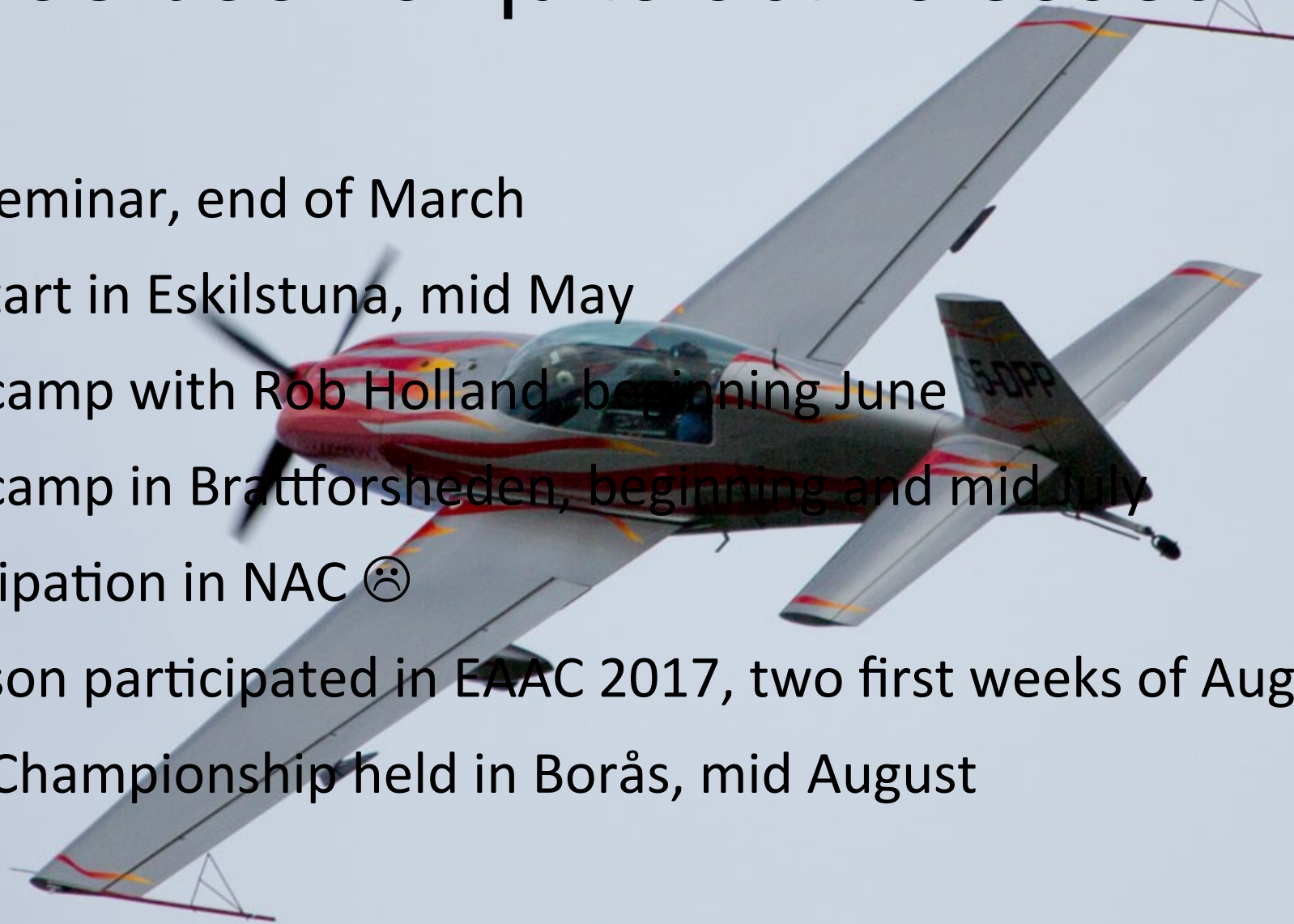

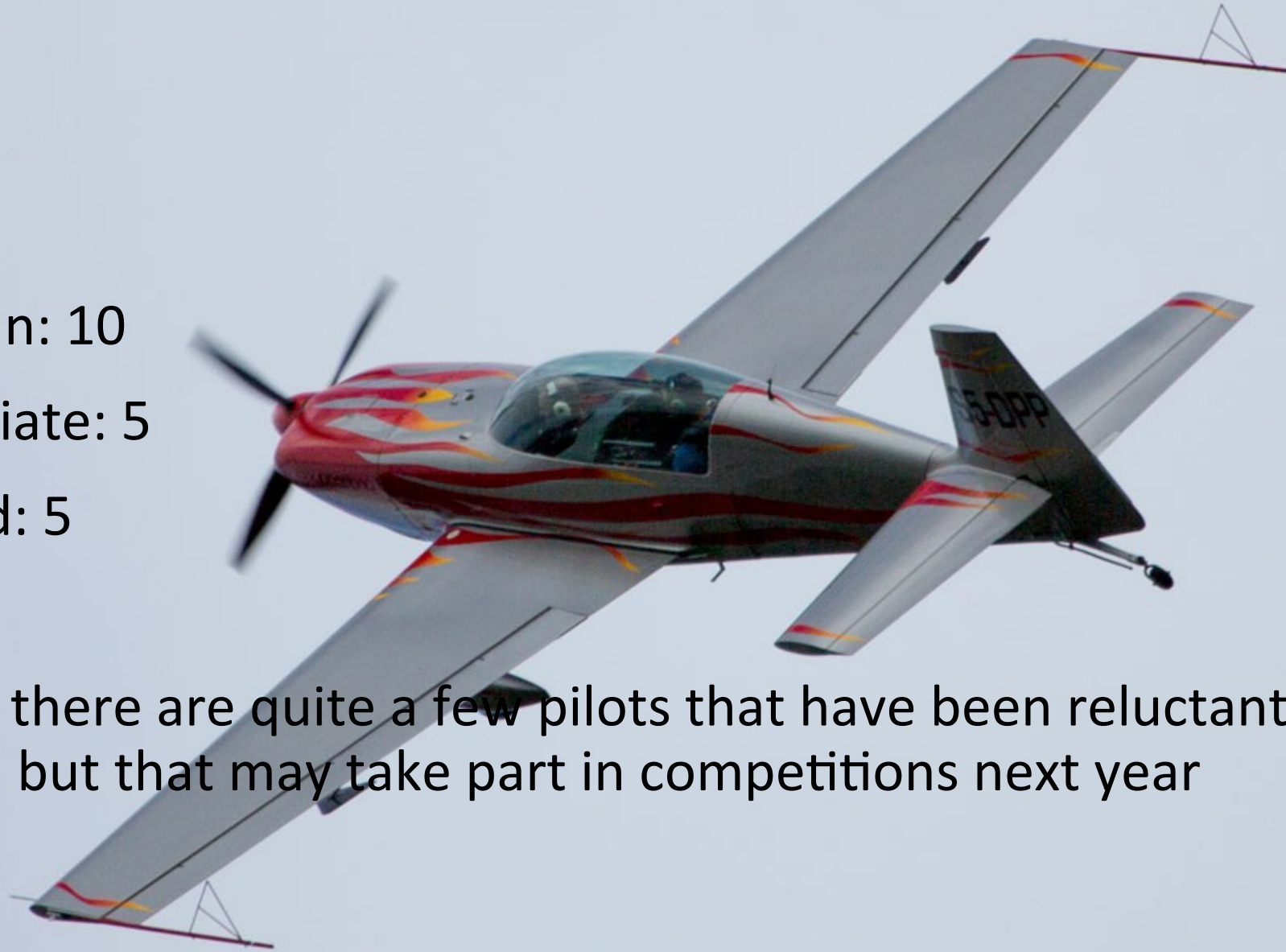
2017 has been a quite active season

- And then there are quite a few pilots that have been reluctant to compete, but that may take part in competitions next year



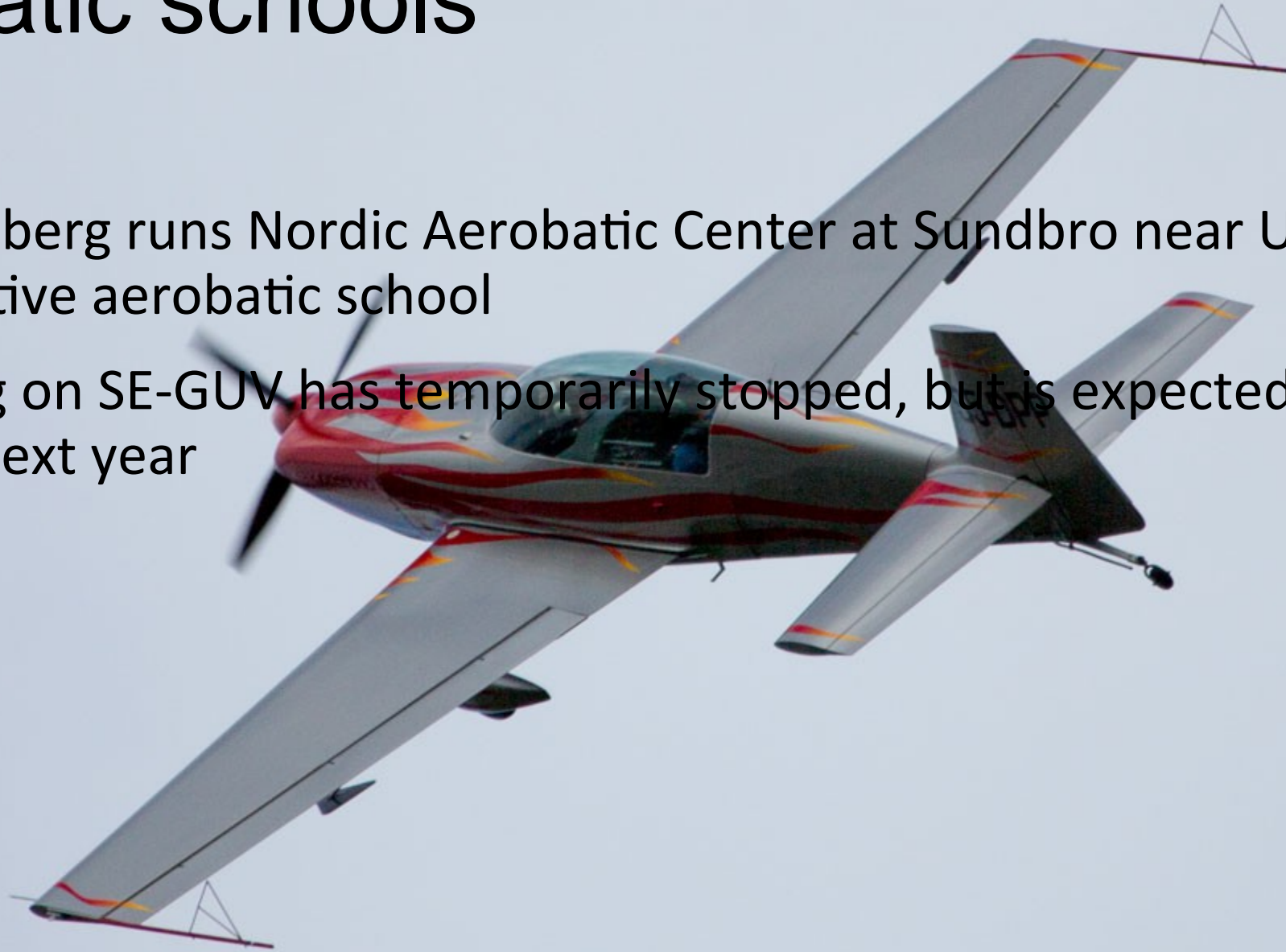

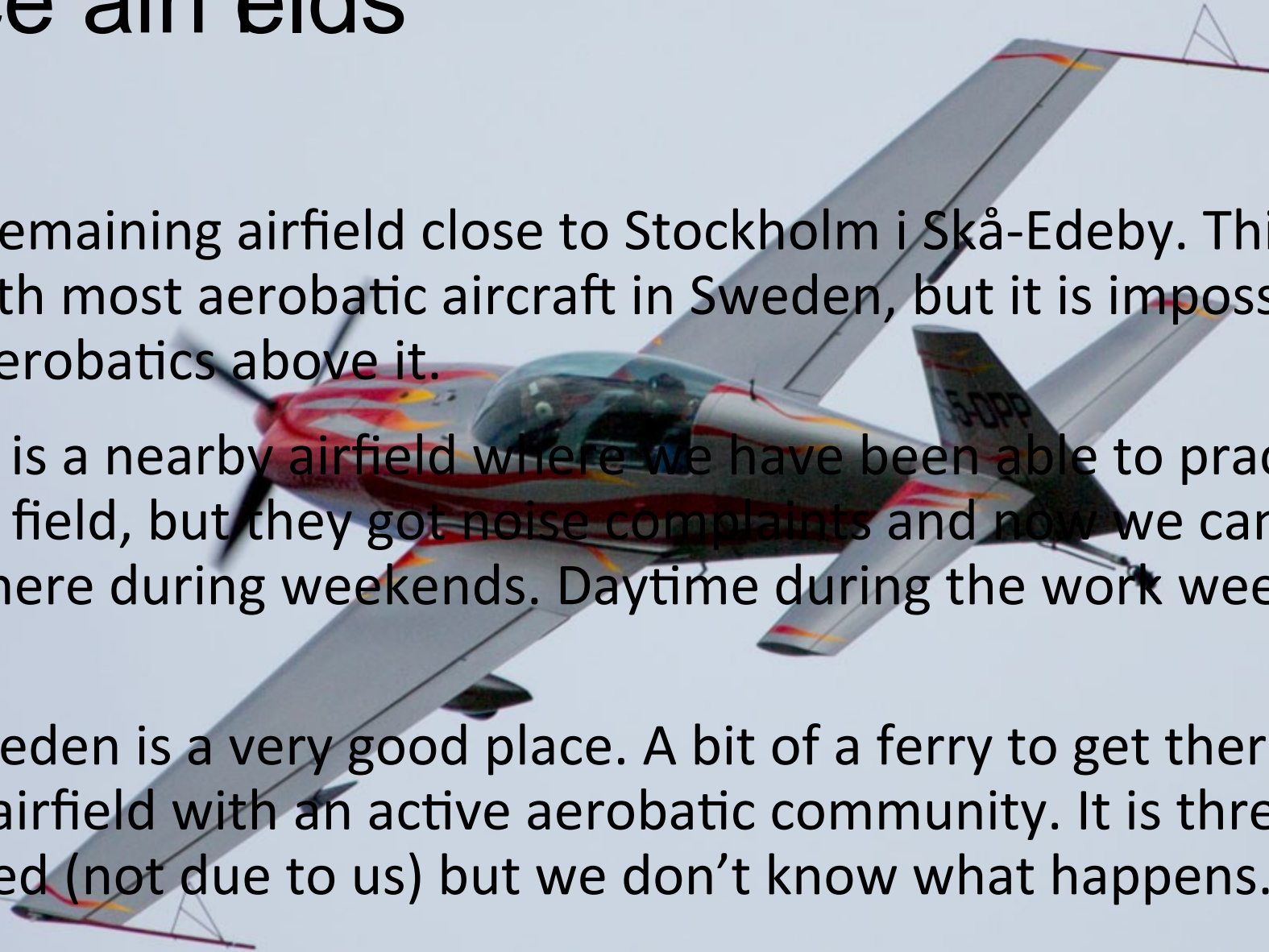
Aerobatic schools

- Patrik Sjöberg runs Nordic Aerobatic Center at Sundbro near Uppsala, a very active aerobatic school
- Schooling on SE-GUV has temporarily stopped, but is expected to resume next year



Practice airfields

- The only remaining airfield close to Stockholm is Skå-Edeby. This is the airfield with most aerobatic aircraft in Sweden, but it is impossible to practice aerobatics above it.
- Eskilstuna is a nearby airfield where we have been able to practice above the field, but they got noise complaints and now we cannot practice there during weekends. Daytime during the work week is still ok.
- Brattforsheden is a very good place. A bit of a ferry to get there, but very nice airfield with an active aerobatic community. It is threatened to be closed (not due to us) but we don't know what happens.
